

The Bronze Ritual Traveling Trophy Rules and Regulations

- Any chapter can challenge the holder of the Bronze Ritual on any meeting day.
- Any ritual, individual or team, is fair game and is issued by the challenging team.
- If a chapter chooses to compete in a team event, all parts must be filled. Arrangements must be made a week prior to the day of the challenge for team competition to ensure parts can be completely filled by both teams. If the parts for a team event cannot be filled by the current trophy holder, another event must be selected. NO DOUBLING ALLOWED!
- The challenging chapter must have at least two DeMolays and two Advisors present from their chapter to compete per youth protection guidelines.
- State Officers/State Officers Emeritus are not allowed to compete in individual competition. Team competition is fair game for everyone.
- If more than one chapter shows up to challenge for competition, one chapter will be chosen at random to challenge for the Bronze Ritual (i.e. coin flip, draw name from a hat, etc.) Only ONE challenge may be issued to the holders per meeting day.
- Standard Conclave-Style judging will be enforced with two word judges and one performance judge. The visiting Advisor will judge performance on the holders of the Bronze Ritual and the home Advisor will judge performance on the visiting Chapter.
- A team/competitor must have at least 500 points to be in contention for the Bronze Ritual.
- In any event of a tie, the win defers to the holders of the Bronze Ritual. The challenging Chapter must have a definitive win to take home the Bronze Ritual.
- If the challenging chapter is successful in defeating the current holder, the challenging chapter takes home the Bronze Ritual with them and gets to keep it safe for one meeting. The victory must be reported to modemolay.org within the next 24 hours so other chapters will know who has the Bronze Ritual.
