History

Frank S. Land founded the young men's organization, DeMolay, nearly 100 years ago where young men modeled their lives according to the Core Values set forth in its principles. All share a common bond in both ideals and promises: "to be better sons, better brothers, and better young men." In the Fall of 2017, a newly formed student organization, the DeMolay Leadership & Service Club, was formed at Maryville University, where young men – and young women – join together in leadership and service to each other and to their community.

The seven Core Values exemplified by DeMolay: "Love of Parents"; "Reverence"; "Courtesy"; "Comradeship"; "Fidelity"; "Cleanness"; and "Patriotism," are qualities to which Maryville University also aspires as a community. Moreover, the ways these values are expressed – through personal development, leadership and service – also reflect the ideals valued and encouraged for students.

Scholarship Criteria

Each academic year, the University's Office of Financial Aid, or designee, may choose the recipient(s) of scholarship(s) in accordance with the University's policies and procedures that are then in effect at the time of the individual award(s). The scholarship will be open to all qualified applicants/students. The following are other criteria to be considered in choosing recipient(s):

- I. Students must be enrolled as full-time students, based on University criteria defining full-time student status.
- II. Students must maintain a minimum cumulative University grade point average of 3.50.
- III. Scholarships may be awarded in conjunction with other University scholarships and/or other types of federal, state or institutional aid.
- IV. Students must submit two letters of recommendation by mentors who know the student well and are able to evaluate the student's commitment to the core values of the Club.
- V. Students must submit a personal statement whereby they communicate their vision of leadership and service in relation to the seven core values: Love of Parents, Reverence, Courtesy, Comradeship, Fidelity, Cleanness and Patriotism.
- VI. Student must be an incoming Freshman or newly active member of the DeMolay Leadership & Service Club at Maryville University and have previously demonstrated leadership experience and a history of community service. This scholarship is not renewable.

Administration

The scholarship funds are managed and disbursed according to Maryville University policies. The above application is to be used for internal use to aid in the selection process and ultimately yields final selection process in accordance with the University's policies and procedures that are then in effect at the time of the individual award(s).
